Biscoff Gingerbread Men

Ingredients

125g salted butter, at room temperature 160g (½ cup) smooth Biscoff spread 100g (½ cup, firmly packed) brown sugar

175g (½ cup) golden syrup

1 egg yolk

450g (3 cups) plain flour

1 tbsp ground ginger

1 tsp mixed spice

1 tsp bicarbonate of soda

Royal icing

2 egg whites 450g (3 cups) pure icing sugar Lemon juice Red liquid food colouring, to tint

To decorate

Red fondant icing
Glucose syrup
Black writing icing, to decorate

Method

Step 1 - Use a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment to beat the butter, Biscoff spread and sugar until pale and creamy. Add golden syrup and egg yolk and beat until combined. Mix in the flour, ginger, mixed spice and bicarb. Turn onto a lightly floured surface. Divide in half. Knead each piece until smooth.

Press into discs, cover with plastic wrap and place in the fridge for 30 minutes.

Step 2 - Preheat an oven to 180C/160C fan forced. Grease 2 baking trays. Line with baking paper.

Step 3 - Place a disc of dough between 2 sheets of baking paper and roll out to around 4mm thick. Use a 12cm gingerbread man pastry cutter to cut out shapes. Arrange on prepared trays. Re-roll any remaining dough.

Step 4 - Bake in a preheated oven for 10 minutes or until browned. Transfer to a wire rack to cool. Repeat with any remaining uncooked biscuits.

Step 5 - To make the royal icing, use electric beaters to cream egg whites in a bowl until soft peaks form. Gradually beat in icing sugar. Beat in a little lemon juice, 1/2 a tsp at a time, until you have your desired consistency. Transfer two-thirds of the icing to a bowl. Add a few drops of food colouring and stir to combine (you may need more food colouring to achieve a bright red colour). Leave the remaining icing white.








Christmas Book
